



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Quarter Reporting for: Apr. 2018 – June 2018

- ➤ 19 Families referred, 17 Families matched Families referred may opt out of participating or may still be in the process of trying to reach them to enroll them within GBYS.
- **Ethnicity** of the families referred:
 - o 52% Caucasian (9 families)
 - o 18% Multiracial (3 families)
 - o 24% Latino (4 families)
 - o 6% African American (1 family)
- > Age of children enrolled in GBYS:
 - o 18% Birth-1 year old
 - o 6% 1-2 years old
 - o 29% 2-3 years old
 - o 35% 3-6 years old
 - o 12% 6 years and older
- **Primary Language** in the home:
 - o English 13 families
 - o Spanish 3 families
 - Dual languages 1 family
- > Newborn Hearing Screening results as reported by the parent:
 - Did Not Pass 8 children
 - o Passed 7 children
 - o Pass/DNP 2 children
- Gender of children enrolled in GBYS:
 - o 8 male, 9 female
- ➤ **Medical History** suggestive of:
 - o Condition assoc. with a hearing loss, 7 children
 - o No known syndrome or etiology 10 children
- ➤ Unilateral vs. Bilateral hearing loss:
 - o Bilateral 13 children
 - Unilateral 3 children
 - o AN 1 child
- Insurance information of enrolled families:
 - Private 12 families
 - o All kids/Medicaid 5 families
