
Quarterly Report July – Sept 2018

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
Quarter Reporting for: July 2018 – Sept. 2018

- 15 Families referred, 10 Families matched Families referred may opt out of participating or may still be in the process of trying to reach them to enroll them within GBYS.
- **Ethnicity** of the families referred:
 - 60% Caucasian (6 families)
 40% Asian American (4 families)
 - 10% Asian American (1 family)
 10% Lating (1 family)
 - 10% Latino (1 family)
 - \circ 10% African American (1 family)
 - 10% Pacific Islander (1 family)
- Age of children enrolled in GBYS:
 - \circ 30% Birth-1 year old
 - \circ 10% 1-2 years old
 - o 20% 2-3 years old
 - o 10% 3-6 years old
 - $\,\circ$ 30% $\,$ 6 years and older $\,$
- Primary Language in the home:
 - English 10 families
 - Spanish 0 families
 - Dual languages 0 families
- Newborn Hearing Screening results as reported by the parent:
 - o Did Not Pass 5 children
 - o Passed 4 children
 - Pass/DNP 1 child
- **Gender** of children enrolled in GBYS:
 - o 6 male, 4 female
- Medical History suggestive of:
 Condition assoc. with a hearing loss, 1 child
 No known syndrome or etiology 6 children
 Hereditary 3 children
- Unilateral vs. Bilateral hearing loss:
 Bilateral 8 children
 - Unilateral 2 children
- Insurance information of enrolled families:
 o Private 7 families
 o All kids/Medicaid 3 families
